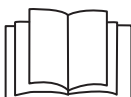

## Safety Instructions

- Position on a flat, stable surface.
- A service agent/qualified technician should carry out installation and any repairs if required. Do not remove any components on this product.
- Consult Local and National Standards to comply with the following:
  - Health and Safety at Work Legislation
  - Fire Precautions
  - IEE Wiring Regulations
  - Building Regulations
- **Warning! Hot surface!** Always wear safety gloves when placing or removing foods.
- DO NOT immerse the appliance in water, or use jet/pressure washers to clean the appliance.
- DO NOT overfill the appliance. Keep the water level below the '**Max**' level.
- DO NOT allow the water level to drop below the '**Min**' level during operation.
- DO NOT move the appliance when it contains hot liquid.
- Do not use the appliance for anything other than its intended use.
- Always switch off and disconnect the power supply to the appliance when not in use.
- Not suitable for outdoor use.
- Keep all packaging away from children. Dispose of the packaging in accordance to the regulations of local authorities.
- If the power cord is damaged, it must be replaced by a Apuro agent or a recommended qualified technician in order to avoid a hazard.



- This appliance must only be used in accordance with these instructions and by persons competent to do so.
- This appliance can be used by children aged from 8 years and above and persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge if they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance in a safe way and understand the hazards involved. Children shall not play with the appliance. Cleaning and user maintenance shall not be made by children without supervision.

## Introduction

Please take a few moments to carefully read through this manual. Correct maintenance and operation of this machine will provide the best possible performance from your Apuro product.

This appliance is intended to be used for commercial applications, for example in kitchens of restaurants, canteens, hospitals and in commercial enterprises such as bakeries and butcheries, but not for continuous mass production of food.

## Pack Contents

The following is included:

- Apuro Heated Buffet Bar
- Gastranorm spacer bars
- Instruction Manual

Apuro prides itself on quality and service, ensuring that at the time of unpacking the contents are supplied fully functional and free of damage.

Should you find any damage as a result of transit, please contact your Apuro dealer immediately.

## Installation

1. Remove the appliance from the packaging. Make sure that all protective plastic film and coatings are thoroughly removed from all surfaces.
2. Maintain a distance of 20cm (7 inches) between the unit and walls or other objects for ventilation.



**Note: Before using the appliance for the first time, clean the shelves and interior with soapy water then dry well.**

3. Set the brakes on the castors to keep the appliance in position.
4. Check to make sure the drainage tap at the upper end of the drainage hose is already closed.

## Operation

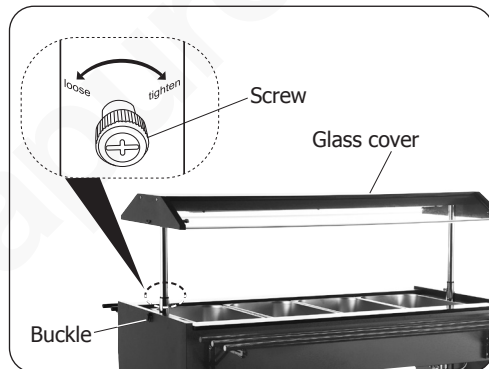
### Storing Food

To get the best results from your Apuro appliance, follow these instructions:

- The appliance is designed for keeping food warm only, not for cooking. Always pre-cook the food.
- Only store foodstuffs in the appliance when it has reached the correct operating temperature.
- Use the spacer bars provided to fill any gaps (they are not required to support each GN pans).
- Always cover the pan with lid when not in use.

### Raise/Lower the glass cover

1. To raise the glass cover, unlock the buckles at two sides first. The glass cover will rise automatically. Then turn the screws clockwise to tighten.
2. To lower the glass cover, loosen the screws first. Then press down the glass cover on both ends simultaneously. Finally lock the buckles in place.



**Note: Do not place heavy objects (e.g., stacked plates) on the glass cover or folding shelves. Use the fixed shelves instead.**

### Filling the water tank

1. Fill the tank with water to a level between the 'Min' and 'Max' marks on the inside of the tank.

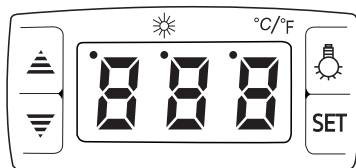


**Note: Never use the appliance without water in the tank, or the food will burn and the appliance will overheat and may get damaged.**

2. Insert the 1/1 GN pans (not supplied) into the water tank.

### Control panel

The control panel is located at the rear of the appliance.



**Heating indicator light:**  
It is on when the appliance is heating.  
It is off when the set temperature is reached.

### Turn On

1. Ensure the power switch is set to [O] and turn on at the socket.
2. Switch on the Power [I].

### Illumination

Press the light button  to switch ON/OFF the lamp underneath the glass cover.

## Adjusting the Temperature

1. Press **SET** button. The set temperature is displayed.
2. Press up button  or down button  to change the set temperature.
3. Press **SET** button to exit.
4. When the set temperature is reached, the heating indicator light goes out.
5. The appliance is now ready for food to be put inside and kept warm.

## Maintaining Water Levels

1. The appliance will beep when the water level is too low. Switch off the Power [O].
2. Remove the GN pans while wearing safety gloves. Then add water carefully to prevent hot water splashing out.

Always keep the water level between the 'Min' and 'Max' marks on the inside of the tank during operation.

Damage to the heating element can occur if the tank boils dry and the element may have to be replaced. This is not covered by the Apuro warranty.

## Thermal Cut-Out Reset

- This appliance is fitted with a Thermal Cut-Out safety feature. Should the temperature exceed safe levels the appliance will automatically cut power.
- Allow the appliance to cool for 30-45 minutes.

## Cleaning, Care & Maintenance

- **Switch off and disconnect the appliance from the power supply. Then allow to cool down before cleaning and maintenance.**
- Wipe down the exterior of the appliance with a damp cloth.
- Remove the GN pans and clean with warm, soapy water and a damp cloth.
- Open the drainage tap to empty the water tank. Then close the tap.
- Clean the interior of the appliance as often as possible.
- Do not use abrasive cleaning agents. These can leave harmful residues.
- Always wipe dry after cleaning.

## Replacing the Lamp

Call your Apuro dealer or a qualified electrician. The Lamp Assembly is available to purchase as a spare part.

## Troubleshooting

A qualified technician must carry out repairs if required.

Fault	Probable Cause	Solution
The appliance is not working	The unit is not switched on	Check the unit is plugged in correctly and switched on
	Plug or lead is damaged	Replace Plug or lead
	Mains power supply fault	Check mains power supply
	Auto re-set activated	Allow product to cool for 30-45 minutes

## Electrical Wiring

The plug is to be connected to a suitable mains socket.

This appliance is wired as follows:

- Live wire (coloured brown) to terminal marked L
- Neutral wire (coloured blue) to terminal marked N
- Earth wire (coloured green/yellow) to terminal marked E



This appliance must be earthed.

If in doubt consult a qualified electrician.

Electrical isolation points must be kept clear of any obstructions. In the event of any emergency disconnection being required they must be readily accessible.

## Compliance

The product must not be disposed of as household waste. To help prevent possible harm to human health and/or the environment, the product must be disposed of in an approved and environmentally safe recycling process.
